Google Classroom	K-12	<p>Easily assign and communicate expectations of assignments. Students can ask questions privately. Create a simple assessment that grades itself using Google Forms. You will have the ability to see which students have accessed their assignments. Create learning groups based on different factors. Embed links for videos and websites. (Khan Academy, Discovery etc.)</p>	<p>Teachers must login first and create classes. NWEA MAP SKILLS	4-8.	<p>Assign ELA and Math Skills to individual students or to the class. You will be able to see if students have completed assigned skills. Assigning Resources gives students access to links for graphs, activities, and websites.(Khan Academy, etc.)</p> <p>Teachers can get help with assigning by selecting Help on the NWEA home page. Search--"Quick Start for Map Skills" and there is also a handout for Parents at the bottom of the page.</p>	<p>Teachers must login and assign Skills and Resources. ACHIEVE 3000	Special Education 7-12 and ELL	<p>Teachers can assign Language Arts lessons to individual students but Reading choices are also available to the student on the opening screen. Teachers can see which students have completed assignments. Teachers and students can communicate through messages on the Achieve 3000 program. Teachers can get additional program information (training videos etc.) by clicking the ? on the bottom right corner of the opening screen.
